

# Fraudulent email notification

Please be aware of fake email messages being sent in the name of the Felician Sisters.

It is not the practice of the Congregation of the Sisters of St. Felix of Cantalice (Felician Sisters) to solicit funds or donations through the internet or email.

Some users have received fake emails that look like they have been sent by Felician Sisters requesting large sums of money. Do not respond to these emails, forward or download any attachments. Delete them from your inbox, and warn your friends.

The email would appear similar to the one below:

*Dear Provincial,*

*I send greetings to you and to all the Sisters in Krakow. You are always in my Prayers. I am writing on behalf of Sr Franc Teresa Luciana the Provincial Bursar of the Congregation of the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word. She has informed me that Sr Maria Eugenia Antonietta their Africa Missions procurator is currently stranded in Krakow, Poland after using the limit of her Visa card. Sr Maria Antonietta is in Poland to purchase a PCR and HSE Machine which is used for blood count in HIV/Aids patients for their hospital in Africa. At the moment the Sisters here do not have any quick means of sending to her the amount of money he urgently require.*

*Sr Franc Luciana has given me Forty Thousand Euros (€40,000) which she told me is equivalent to One Hundred Sixty Four Thousand Polish Zloty (164,000zl) I have the money in our account. I request you to give Sr Maria Antonietta the 164,000zl which she urgently require then you let me know on which Bank account I should Transfer the money.*
